## **Ephesians 5:1-20**

1 Timothy 4:1 starts with "The Spirit...", and it seems clear to us Paul is referring to the Holy Spirit of God. But what did Christians in Ephesus <u>understand</u>? After all, the first three chapters have no teaching about the Holy Spirit...
