Nine of the men obeyed Jesus and went to the temple. Did the tenth man disobey? Or, since he was not Jewish, did that law not apply to him?

Do we live in a world that values a grateful spirit? If not, how do we escape the negativity of our age?

Is getting close to those who are hurting – like Jesus did, despite potential risk to us, part of being thankful?
