Luke 16:19-31

Matthew 25:41 Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels.

Matthew 25:46 They will go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life.

Matthew 25:30 Throw that worthless servant outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.
(also Matt. 8:12, 22:13)

Revelation 21:8 They will be consigned to the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the second death.

Matthew 10:28 Be afraid of the One who can destroy both soul and body in hell.

2 Peter 3:8-10 He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.

Hebrews 9:27 People are destined to die once, and after that to face judgment.

John 11:25-26 The one believes in me will live, even though they die, and whoever lives and believes in me shall never die.

John 5:28-29 A time is coming when all who are in their graves will hear his voice and come out – those who have done what is good will rise to live, and those who have done what is evil will rise to be condemned.
