All His Fullness

Col. 1:15-23

Most New Testament books were written by eye witnesses, people who had seen, heard and walked with Jesus. We were not there, so must believe by faith. But we lose sight of the fact that most early believers were in our same situation; those in Colossae were among them. They had not seen Jesus. In fact they had less than we do – we have the Gospel accounts, they did not have those available yet, only the verbal teaching handed down. So Paul teaches them truth about Jesus, and about themselves.

Ponder these truths, and write a prayer of praise and repentance:

Jesus is God's Son, the Creator

He holds everything together

He is the head of the body, the church

He must have supremacy in everything

All of God's fullness dwells in Jesus

The cross brings reconciliation, to those who believe

Our evil behavior alienated us from God

We are free from accusation regarding our past, if we cling to the Gospel and grow in our faith
