The Ten Commandments

Bible scholars estimate that the Exodus of the Israelite slaves from Egypt occurred around 1,500 years before Christ. Do you think 3,500-year-old laws are a bit outdated? Or do they still serve us well today?

What kind of impression of God do you get, reading the 10 Commandments?

Read Exodus 32 and try to imagine the reaction of Moses. Do you think God responds in a similar way when we ignore his commands, or blatantly disobey?

Read the commandments aloud, and then write a prayer, asking for the help of the Holy Spirit with the commandment/s you have the most trouble obeying:

- 1) You shall have no other gods before me
- 2) You shall not make for yourself any image or idol
- 3) You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God
- 4) Remember the Sabbath Day by keeping it holy
- 5) Honor your father and your mother
- 6) You shall not murder
- 7) You shall not commit adultery
- 8) You shall not steal
- 9) You shall not give false testimony
- 10) You shall not covet
