Start Here

John 6:35, Mark 8:27-30

What does a true disciple (follower) of Jesus look like? Obviously the answer is not related to physical characteristics. This series will help us understand what Jesus expected of those who chose to follow, and challenge us to align our lives with these 'marks' or evidences. These verses explain the first step = belief.

Repent and believe the good news. Mark 1:15

I do believe; help me overcome my unbelief. Mark 9:24

John came as a witness concerning the light (Jesus), so that through him all might believe. John 1:7

To all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God. John 1:12

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16

Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because they have not believed in the name of God's Son. John 3:18

The work of God is this; to believe in the one he has sent. John 6:29

Simon Peter said: "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and to know that you are the Holy One of God."

John 6:68-69

Jesus said: "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?" John 11:25-26
