

This is My Story: Isaiah

Isaiah was from Jerusalem, and prophesied the words of God to four kings of Judah, from 760 to 673 BC.

Overview of the book:

God tires of religion without heart worship – ch. 1

Isaiah prophecies against many nations/peoples – ch. 9-23

The book contains many songs of praise, not found in all of the prophets:
Ch. 2, 12, 25, 26, 27, 35, 42

At least eight chapters contain Messianic prophecies, small hints that would help Israel identify the promised Savior – see if you can list some of these

The book contains other well-known messages, for example ch. 58 about true fasting

See also chapters 55, 59, 61

The most well-known passage of the book is Isa. 6, his call and commission to ministry

Is this something you desire, to “see” the Lord?

Compare Isaiah’s reaction to how you think you might feel?

Read Matthew 27 re the death of Jesus, and observe parallels with Isaiah’s experience:

John 1:14 – describe in what way/s you feel that you have “seen” Jesus
